

# The Farrells



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This paper was come to through researching Bruce Springsteen, who is a Farrell from Ireland on his father's side. Which brought Will Ferrell (formerly Farrell) into the mix as well as Colin Farrell. Colin has said he is 98.7% Irish, which may or may not be true in one sense, but in another sense it isn't true at all, as we about to see. All these people are famous, so we know they are Phoenician Navy.

Colin is from the Tyrrells, which tells us that without further study. That comes from Tyre, of course, the old capital of Phoenicia. Think the Tyrell Corporation in *Blade Runner*, also a nod to the Phoenicians. Colin is from South Dublin, and the prominent Tyrrells are from Strathmore Castle south of there in Killiney. It later became the residence of the Canadian ambassador.



It is now next door to Bono's mansion, and has been expanded by the rich guy who owns it to compete with him. Killiney is sort of like an Irish Hamptons, telling us who these Tyrrells were and are. A trip to the peerage also tells us, since we find them closely linked to the [East India Company](#). Ada Tyrrell married Sir John Perronet Thompson in about 1910, and he was Chief Commissioner of Delhi. Their daughter married the Baronet Wakefield, and their son hit the big time, marrying a [Baring](#) of Barings Banks. His brother also married a Baring.

Colin comes out of the prestigious Castleknock College, so they don't even bother to try to sell him as the son of a truck driver or possum trapper, which is mildly refreshing. He also went to [Gormanston](#) College, which probably looks nothing like the college you went to:



He also went to the Gaiety School of Acting, which is pretty funny. No comment needed. Like others we have seen, he didn't even need a diploma, getting cast—after just a year of doing nothing at Gaiety—in the BBC's *Ballykissangel* and *Falling for a Dancer* at age 21. The next year he was in Tim Roth's *The War Zone* and *Ordinary Decent Criminal*, with Kevin Spacey. Also Joel Schumacher's *Tigerland*. So Colin was definitely on the fast track. We may assume it was not because his dad played for the

Rovers. By age 25 he was working with Spielberg.

These Tyrrells also include the Baron Tyrrell, d. 1947, who was Privy Counsellor and President of the British Board of Film Censors. So there is our film link right there. He was Privy Counsellor and Order of the Bath. His daughter married a Crawshay/Leslie, linking us to the Seymours. This also linked him to the iron billionaires of Wales, the Crawshays (later Baileys), as well as to the Townshends. The Baileys later married the Russells and became Barons. Another daughter married a Renton, their son becoming the Baron Renton and marrying a Fergusson (who was also a Balfour and Dugdale through his mother). Wikipedia conveniently forgets to mention his daughters and these links. Also forgets to mention that his wife the Urquhart linked him to the Douglasses, Earls of Angus, and the Grahams of Morphie.

Also see Lt. Col. George Montague Tyrrell, who married Eva St. John of the St. John Barons of Bletso. Eva's brother married a Hamilton Russell. That's because these St. Johns were also. . . Tudors.

The first Tyrrell baronetcy goes back to 1627, and they come out of the Montagues of Thornton, Buckinghamshire. So Colin Farrell is not Irish in that line. These Montagues are related to Dudleys, and although although Lundy scrubs them before 1400, we know who they are. They are Stuarts, and they link us forward to George Washington, among many others. By 1600 they are the Earls of Manchester, marrying Spencers. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Earl married the daughter of Robert Rich, linking us that old intrigue. His grandson became the Duke of Manchester, Secretary of State to the South, which is our link to Washington. The second duke married his cousin, also daughter of a Montagu duke and a Churchill, linking those two families. Yes, the Montagues held two dukedoms at the time. So anyway, the Irish Tyrrells were and are cousins of the Montagu dukes.

These Tyrrells of Dublin came over to the US very early, with one of them being involved in the aftermath of the Lincoln assassination, as part of the Pinkerton agency and US Secret Service. See, Patrick Tyrrell, famous for foiling the attempt to steal Lincoln's body. His 2g-grandson Emmett Tyrrell is also famous as the editor of the *American Spectator* and fellow at the Hoover Institution.

Colin's grandfather is a Monaghan, and we also find Monaghans of Dublin in the peerage going back to 1840, though they are pretty well scrubbed. They appear to be listed because of the Fagans, Jewish of course, and mayors of Dublin back to the 1500s. That's because they too were East India Company. See Maj. Gen. Christopher Fagan, d. 1845, for instance, who ended up coming to Philadelphia.

Ethnicelebs gives great-grandparents for Colin in only one of four lines, not including the Monaghan line, indicating something is being hidden there. [Colin claims on Youtube](#) he took the 23andMe DNA test, though he shows no paperwork there: we just have to take his word for it. But if he knows his DNA to within a tenth (98.7% Irish), he should know his great-grandparents. Almost everyone knows their own great-grandparents. But it isn't only Ethnicelebs hiding his lines: Geni lists him as the son of private and private. So why even publish that empty listing?

What about other peerage Farrells from Dublin? Well, we find a Brian Farrell, lecturer in politics at University College Dublin in the 1960s. These Farrells come from Manchester, so Colin may not be Irish in that line, either.

Also Francis Arthur Farrell of Dublin, d. 1914, with his brother linking us to the Prestons, Viscounts of Gormanston. Do you remember where Colin went to school? Gormanston College. They link us to the Southwell viscounts, who link us to the Hamiltons again. Also to the Berkeleys and Comptons.

Also to the Scropes and de Laskis.

And we have a crosslink to my paper on Michael Collins. The physician to the Viscount Gormanston was Oliver **St. John** Gogarty, who was not only lampooned as Buck Mulligan in James Joyce's *Ulysses*, he was also the coroner for Michael Collins and Arthur Griffith. So, a major spook.

Also see Maj. Charles Farrell, who married a **Paget** in 1949. Her father was the Marquess of **Anglesey** and her mother was a Manners, of the Dukes of Rutland. Their daughter married a Lane-Fox, linking us to the Buckleys and Steins, as well as to the **Pitts**. So if you thought there was some wild similarity between Colin Farrell and Brad Pitt, you may be right.

Also see William John **de Courcy** Farrell, whose mother was a **Beamish**. His grandmother was a de Courcy of the Lords of Kingsale. He married a **Fleming** and moved to New Jersey in about 1950.

Which brings us to Will Ferrell. His great-grandfather is given as John William Ferrell, same as himself. We just saw William John Farrell. Coincidence? Maybe. Except that Will's great-grandmother is given as Emily **Murray**, another red flag. William John has three wives listed, so maybe he had a fourth as well. As with Colin Farrell, **Geni.com** scrubs Will Ferrell completely. But we know one of his great-grandparents was a Marks. **Marks=Marx**, and that line is also soon scrubbed, for obvious reasons. However, Tim Dowling helps us out a bit, [admitting he is a 13<sup>th</sup> cousin of these Marks](#), meaning they are related somehow to the Stuarts. But Tim Dowling scrubs the Murrays out of the Ferrell line, pretty much admitting there is action there was well. The Murrays are the same as Stanleys at the top of the peerage, so this links us to the Stuarts again. And we know the Marx are closely related to the Philips/Phillips, linking us that way to King Charles.

To figure it out, we have to keep following lines back, to see which Will Ferrell line Tim Dowling hugs most closely. That would be the Eltonheads, and we soon see why, [since they do indeed take us to the Stanleys](#). By the time we get to Peter Stanley, Tim Dowling is a second cousin 17x removed. So why would Dowling admit this in the Marks line but scrub the Murrays in the Ferrell line? Probably because the link to the Stanleys is much shorter there, and you could find it without going back to the year 1400. He figures no one is going to do that.

This indicates Will Ferrell is a cousin of both Bill Murray and Chevy Chase, which goes some way to explaining why they had a similar career arc.

Now, what about Bruce Springsteen? First of all, I find it hilarious that someone named Springsteen, which would have originally been Springstein, of course, would claim to be Irish/Italian, with no Jewish blood. It would be like Jerry Seinfeld claiming to be 100% Irish/Italian. But first let's hit his mother, a Zerilli whose family is from Naples. Her name is Adele, which is not an Italian name. It is short for Adaline, of course, which is Old High German meaning "noble". So we already have a big clue the Zerillis are not Italian. Zerilli is the diminutive of Zeri, [which is Hebrew for "stone"](#). Also spelled Suri. So we have this one pegged already.

And Bruce's Zerillis are not just from Naples, but the wealthy port **Vico Equense**, which has been a Phoenician retreat since the time of Ancient Rome.



Roman patricians built their homes there before the time of Christ. King Charles II built a castle and gothic cathedral there in 1300. Also interesting is that Springsteen dedicated “My Hometown” to this place. Pretty strange, since it was his grandfather's hometown, not his. But the Phoenicians love their history.

We are told his grandfather Zerilli came through Ellis Island, as if he was a poor emigrant. Except for one thing: the Zerillis weren't poor emigrants, they were rich actors and mobsters. See Anthony and Joseph Zerilli, heads of the Detroit mob we have looked at before. Remember the **Purple Gang** I laughed about in my [paper on Al Capone](#). That was these bozos.



More Actors Equity midgets hired by J. Edgar Hoover to give FBI something to spend your taxdollars

on. Joseph Zerilli supposedly joined the Purple Gang right off the boat, and that was put together by Abraham Bernstein, in case you forgot. He was not 98.7% Irish, in case you are wondering. So why did Zerilli join a Jewish gang? Now you know.

On his father's side, they admit the Springsteens are not Irish, but Dutch, with a stop-over in Ireland. Bruce's father goes by the name "Dutch". Doesn't really fit the image we have been sold, does it? Did you ever think of Bruce as Dutch? Geni scrubs all the women in the Springsteen line, which is very suspicious. Finally, in the 1700s we find one given as a Seger of New York, which of course links us to Pete Seeger and my research on him. Confirming that, we remember Bruce did a whole album dedicated to Pete Seeger, though we are never told why. Now you know.

These Segers are also Jewish. They are also Thyssens in Bruce's lineage. See the bankroller of Hitler. They admit Springsteen's ancestor is Casper Springsteen, who came over directly from Groningen—with no stop-over in Ireland—but they forget to give you his middle name: Melchior. He was Melchior Springsteyn, probably a rich Jewish banker. He was among those few chosen by hand by Director General Stuyvesant (Jewish) to settle Bushwick, Brooklyn. They admit this was a Dutch West India Company colony, so the 22 men chosen would be prominent in the Company, as either shipowners, bankers, or other merchants. They were not coming over for religious freedom, as we have been taught. They were establishing a New Netherlands for trading purposes.

We are supposed to believe all records of Dutch Brooklyn were destroyed in 1854 when someone contemptuously threw them all out. Right, I'm sure that happened. We can be certain they were taken for some Phoenician archive, perhaps in the Smithsonian vaults with the Ark of the Covenant (see *Indiana Jones*). Just joking. Mostly. I am sure they still exist somewhere, they just don't want any Gentiles having access to them, for what you are beginning to understand are obvious reasons.

They admit the Phoenicians were busy with their usual jobs in Bushwick: big factories were built much earlier than you would think, spewing out chemicals, glue, sugar, oil, coal, beer, and commercial acids. Everything but heroin and Fentanyl, I guess.

In the early years, the Springsteens were closely related to the Rees of Germany, who came over with them with the Dutch West India Company. Both families soon moved to New Jersey. They also went by Race, since that is how it is pronounced in Dutch. But the name Rees should look familiar to you, since they also went to England. See my paper on Princess Diana, where a Rees is the central figure. Around 1800 these Springsteens married the Bushes, see Elizabeth Springsteen who married Abraham Bush.

One of the Springsteen women hidden in the 1800s is Harriet Borden, perhaps linking us to the Bordens of Massachusetts and the Lizzie Borden fake. We also find a William Allen Springsteen mysteriously scrubbed in those years, with his long dead children being given as private. Why? I couldn't discover it. He probably links us directly to Cohens. But I did discover with some digging at Geni that Bruce's great-uncle Clarence married a Winona Rhodes. They are also Applegates. So Bruce is a cousin of Christina Applegate. These Rhodes are soon scrubbed, but we know who they are. Her brother married a Koch from Perth Amboy, NJ, and we know who they are as well. Her aunt married a Morgan who was also a Phipps and a Buckwalter, so we have them pegged as well. These are the Morgans of Phoenixville, PA. Any questions? They have their own obelisk in Morris cemetery. The Buchwalters are from Zurich, and Findagrave tries to sell them as Mennonite farmers. Right, because Mennonite famers always come from big cities, marry Rhodes, and bury themselves under huge obelisks.



What about Bruce's O'Hagans? They apparently came over from Ireland in about 1860, but William O'Hagan is scrubbed. Geni tells us his wife was a Reily, while Ethnicelebs says she was a McCann. So one and probably both are lying. But we do know that the O'Hagans in Dublin at that time were Barons. See Thomas O'Hagan, 1<sup>st</sup> Baron of Tullahogue, Privy Counsellor and [Lord Chancellor of Ireland](#). Wow. He married a Townley, daughter of a [Molyneux](#), linking us to the Earl of Sefton as well as the Drummonds and Stanhopes. The Stanhope Earls link us directly to Charles Fitzroy, [Duke of Grafton](#) and grandson of Charles II.



Thomas was apparently not the 1<sup>st</sup> Baron of Tullahogue, since there is a previous one listed as John O'Hagan, Baron of Tullagh-og, county Tyrone. He married a McMahon of the Barons of Furney. But since these listings are not dated, I don't know how far back that goes. Finally I found it was a very long time ago, about 1200. Also found something very interesting, [since King John commanded a Patrick O'Hagan](#) of these Barons to change his name to . . . Fagan. So O'Hagan=Fagan. I didn't see that coming, but it links us to research above and to the Monaghans in Colin Farrell's genealogy. So we have crosslinks no one could have predicted here. These Fagans moved to county Meath and married the [Fitzgeralds, Earls of Kildare](#). They were attainted in those years in the Perkin Warbeck

rebellion against Henry VIII. In the 1600s they regained titles and married the **Balls**, linking us again to George Washington. In the 1700s they were in Kerry marrying the Fitzmaurices. Robert Fagan moved to Philadelphia, where his son was the Maj. Gen. Christopher Fagan we saw above. His granddaughter married the Monaghan, linking us to Colin Farrell.

We can also link the Farrells to the Fitzgeralds through the Skeffingtons. The Skeffingtons were originally Levesons from Trentham, but by 1529 they were Lord Deputies of Ireland, living in Dublin. See Sir William Skeffington, knighted by Henry VII and given the Duke of Buckingham's (Stafford) seized property in Tunbridge by Henry VIII. Skeffington is the one who destroyed the Earls of Kildare (Fitzgeralds) and their Maynooth castle in 1534. His grandson became the 1<sup>st</sup> Baronet of Fisherwicke, and his grandson became the 1<sup>st</sup> Viscount Massareene, county Antrim. The 4<sup>th</sup> Viscount hit the big time again, marrying a Chicester of those earls, which also linked him to the Boyles, Forbes, and Howards (Dukes of Norfolk). His son became an Earl and married an Eyre, with his son linking them to the Hamiltons. The male line died out at that time, but his daughter married a Foster of the Barons of Oriel, and he took the name Skeffington. The Skeffingtons were still very prominent at that point (1809), being Privy Council, and by that time they owned property and titles all over Ireland, being not only the Viscounts Massareene in Antrim, but the Barons Oriel in Louth. In 1870 they joined the Whyte-Melvilles, who were also Osbornes, Dukes of Leeds.

Now comes the weird part: Wikipedia admits that another Farrell became a baronet in 1786, taking over Skeffington Hall from his father, whose mother was Elizabeth Skeffington. So proud was he of that name he added it to his own, becoming Farrell-Skeffington. For obvious reasons: it linked him to the Howard and Hamilton dukedoms. Problem is, he isn't listed in the peerage. Lundy has scrubbed him for some reason, and the only reason I can think of is to screen Colin Farrell from this link. It is a damning link, because it also links us to the Townshends, Clements, Webbs, Beresfords and Gores. It proves the Farrells of Dublin were and are closely linked to the families that have been running Ireland for centuries.

But not just Ireland. Also Argentina. See Edelmiro Farrell, President of Argentina at the end of WWII before Peron. They admit he was the grandson of Matthew Farrell of Ireland, of the Princes of Annaly and Bishops of Ardagh. Originally clan O Fearghail, from county Longford (west of Dublin). We are told they were destroyed by James I in the 1600s, but as you see that isn't exactly true. They married into many English/Phoenician lines like the Skeffingtons/Levesons, and maintain much of their power today.

And guess what? This Matthew Farrell is also not listed in the peerage, since although he was from a line of Irish princes, he was not a *British* peer. But as you see, that did not stop these Farrells from running Argentina.

This is also interesting: who do you think built the current MI6 building? That would be Sir Terry Farrell, of the Irish Farrells. He also built the Home Office Building and Charing Cross Station.

I also remind you of Mike Farrell of MASH, whose mother is a Cosgrove and whose ex-wife is Shelley Fabares—Jewish of course. Fabares is also an Eyler and she was formerly married to Lou Adler. Half [of Mike's lines are scrubbed at Geneanet](#), which is suspicious, since he is still alive. Why not just ask him? He may be an Eyre in one of those lines. Why? Because Tim Dowling admits Mike is a Devitt in the Farrell line, and as we just saw, the Farrells are also Eyres. Well, if we consult thepeerage.com, we find the Devitts there are also. . . Eyres. See Maj. Philip Eyre Devitt, son of Herbert Pye-Smith Devitt, of the Devitt baronets. This Devitt married a Leslie of Bath, and as we saw above, the Farrells



are also Leslies through the Tyrrells. So Tim Dowling gave me too much information as usual, despite scrubbing half of Mike's lines. Isn't that the way it always is?

What about Irish broadcaster Brian Farrell? Well, he links to all these other people not only through Manchester, which we saw above, but through his wife, Marie-Therese Dillon. Her uncle is the famous James Dillon of Fine Gael, and these Dillons have been marrying the Farrells for centuries. They are in the lines of the peerage Farrells we were looking at above. See for example Ellen Dillon, whose son Maj. Kelly married Henrietta Skeffington.

We can also link to the Chief of Field Operations for the Manhattan Project, Maj. Gen. Thomas Farrell. They tell us his father was a pig farmer in Troy, NY. That's a new one. As a Lt. Colonel he was Leslie Groves executive officer in 1941, and Groves picked him in 1944 as his deputy for the Manhattan project.



He was one of the Tinian Joint Chiefs who oversaw the fake nuking of Japan, which including the faking of that photo. After the war he became advisor to Bernard Baruch on the Atomic Energy Commission, another fake. So this is what Farrells do. We know he comes from these Farrells since his daughter married. . . a Dillon. His grandson was CEO of Dominion Energy.
