THE MOST TERRIFYING IQ STATISTIC?

In <u>this youtube video</u>, Jordan Peterson tells us the greatest tragedy of IQ is that ten percent of the human population is not qualified to do anything in the military. Peterson says that means they also are basically unemployable in the greater world, which isn't strictly true, but we see his point. It is indeed a tragedy that the New World Order has no place for 10% of the population, as a matter of employment.

But although that is a big problem, it isn't anything like the most terrifying IQ statistic, or the greatest problem. Why? Because it could be solved with one stroke of the pen. Congress could meet for one day and solve it, by outlawing robots and automation in most work places. Or by outlawing certain machines on farms. Or in any number of other ways. That is where these people used to be employed. But now unskilled labor has been taken over by machines and robots. A fraction of that takeover is probably reasonable, since we don't want people doing dangerous or overly monotonous line work. We don't want to make these people slaves or drones. But we also don't want to throw them on the streets or on the dole simply so that corporations can save a few dollars, redirecting that profit to their CEOs.

I will be told there is no fighting progress and no going back. I will be told we can't just outlaw machines. But none of that is true. It clearly isn't progress, and calling it progress is just corporate propaganda. And we can go back any time we like. There is no rule of history that says we can't admit to mistakes and correct them. That is just more corporate propaganda. And we can outlaw anything we like. That is what laws are for: to keep society from spinning out of control like it is right now. So this is actually not an insoluble problem, and is therefore not really terrifying at all. It could easily be solved.

The greater problem of IQ and US employment is that modern society doesn't have many good jobs for A large fraction of work now done is work that simply doesn't need to be done. anvone. It is destructive, predatory, and unsustainable. It is work done in the production of products that should have never been invented or produced to start with. Even in food production, which would seem at first to be an exception to that, it is true, since most food now on the shelves or in the restaurants is tainted, unhealthy, and often poisoned. It is saturated with GMO oils and greases, modified beet sugar, white flour, white rice, medicated beef and chicken, and a thousand other vile things. Most food in the US isn't fit for human consumption or animal consumption. The same thing goes for the medical industry, which should be an exception to that rule, but which actually proves it as much as any other field—as this fake Covid pandemic has shown beyond any doubt. A large percentage of the medical profession and industry is fraudulent, harmful, and often lethal. It profits off human suffering by creating it and exacerbating it. Same for the fields of politics, media, intelligence, science, and academia. The universities have been completely bought out by the corporatocracy as well, and the number of decent jobs there is also approaching zero.

But the point is, the American system did its best to waste me. Once I refused the corporate and military paths, the overlords kicked me into the ditch with at least as much disregard as they show for any sub-80 IQ person. They left the door cracked into the realist art scene, as in Santa Fe, and I crawled out of the gutter into that, but even there they owned all the galleries and had a long list of rules posted. You were expected to turn yourself into a hack as quickly as possible and paint what you were told, basically being a decorator for the tasteless. So my future was not bright there either.

So while it worked in my case, I wouldn't recommend it as a general method of encouraging excellence. We can be sure that this discouragement most often works, and that far more research has been destroyed than sharpened by such inhospitality. For every one like me that breaks through anyway, there must thousands or millions who were successfully silenced. And even my story is not told yet. They may find some way to squelch me yet, in which case I will join the billions. That won't end it (see previous paper), but it would be a shame nonetheless.

Call me elitist, but I see the purposeful squashing and debilitating of our top end a far greater tragedy to the history of mankind than the loss of some fruit-picking or assembly-line jobs. Don't get me wrong, I think that problem should be solved in favor of the workers, with the machines scrapped, and if I were king I would make it happen immediately. But, being that we are on the cusp of a complete and total revolution in physics and all the sciences, one that will make all previous ones look like blips, our top 1% in IQ are more crucial than ever.
