Rikkie Kolle not a biological male

They tell us the internet is divided on Kolle, but as usual I will take a third side, showing you what no one else is.

Just to restate my baseline, for those who are just getting here, I have no problem with gays. I have no problem with intersex or even crossdressers. I don't want to hang out with crossdressers, but beyond that freedom is freedom. They can do what they wish. Charles Barkley has come out and said the same thing, and I agree with him that far. But that isn't the question here, because this has gone way beyond a question of freedom or rights. Homosexuality and transgenderism are now being aggressively promoted to children and everyone else, and that isn't being done to protect the rights of LGBT. It isn't a question of progress. It is a question of manufactured chaos, population control, and squelching of revolution. This isn't a natural eruption of human nature, it is a major Intelligence project. Kolle just famously won Miss Netherlands, allegedly being the first biological male to do so. But as usual, I am not buying it. I had my doubts the first time I saw her picture, and after listening to an interview and studying more photos, I am almost sure she isn't a male and never was. My belief is they found this tall model with some masculine characteristics, then sold her as a former male to further

confuse everyone. You can't tell me they wouldn't do that, since we know they are doing everything they can to confuse us sexually now. This would just be one small thing to add to an already endless list of sexual confusion.

Why do I think this? First and most important, her voice. That is exhibit A here,* and you have to take that link. It is quite high and soft, very feminine. And she is not faking it. A male simply cannot fake a voice like that. The transitioning drugs have trouble getting to the vocal chords, and trannies that I have heard don't have voices like this. It is very difficult to create a high feminine voice with drugs, and trannies give themselves away with their voices. Second, her neck. I don't see an Adam's apple or any scars from removing it or shaving it down. The scar should be very recent and raw, since we are told she had no surgery until January of this year. But we don't see that. Third, her ribcage and shoulders are too narrow. Transitioning drugs can change secondary characteristics, but they can't rebuild a skeleton that has already formed.



There she is as a teen, a little chubby, but no sign of being a boy. The neck is completely feminine.

I leave open the possibility she was born intersex, leaning to female, and <u>this website</u> seems to confirm that:

Before Rikkie's surgery, her male hormones seemed to be more dominant than her female hormones. This was evident in her body structure, her breasts were underdeveloped, and she was more muscular. She had to use female hormones so as to make her male hormones less dominant.

Rikkie developed more female traits. Her breasts fully developed and she was less muscular. I guess the surgery was a success and the hormones were working.

Except for one thing. That photo is a paste-up, confirming we are being yanked here. Websites like this are created by CIA bots, which is pretty obvious once you study them. The language is always very weird, so they are either created by highschool kids in the Punjab or by AI.

And another thing: she didn't have surgery until this year, so anything that happened before 2023 wasn't due to surgery. Her breasts are not implants, which is another clue we should have gotten at a first look at her winning photos as Miss Netherlands. And I did. Not only do they look real, they are small b-cups, like you would expect to see on a thin model. But women who get surgery almost never go for b-cups. Especially tall women and especially now. They don't want little undersized breasts, they want c-cups or maybe even d-cups. Doubly true for girls going into pageants. B-cups on a 6-footer don't normally score points with judges. Most high-profile trannies opt for breast implants, since they are far easier to choose than genital surgery. Because what we are looking at is unaltered, that is one more indication the story may be false.

That would seem to affirm we are in the middle of a project here, which takes us back to where we started: most likely Kolle isn't intersex at all. She is a tall biological female who—perhaps due to her Moluccan ancestry—has large hands. Some may read her other exotic traits as male, but that is a misread.

That same website tries to pass off this as a before and after photo:



You have to laugh, but some people will buy it. That site is very highly listed and comes up near the top on searches.



She has <u>a model portfolio</u> online with lots of pics from when she was a teen, like that one. These were all before any surgery, and may have been before hormone therapy, so they don't tend to confirm the story. I couldn't find any pictures of her when she was supposed to be a boy, or pre-hormone therapy.



A Google search on that question brings up nothing except photos like that. That photo doesn't say "boy" to me. If it does to you, I would say they have got to you. You are confused.

That picture embargo from Google is pretty conclusive, since you would think her family would have lots of photos of her from when she was a child, to show the miraculous transformation. Instead, we find no signs of *any* transformation. A trannie with no transformation. Always thought she was a girl and always looked like one, so where is the transformation?

We are told she started hormone therapy at 15, which also makes no sense. Most girls go through puberty much earlier than that now. When I was a kid, girls went through puberty at 12-14. But that was two generations ago now, and the age of menarche has dropped considerably since then. So to catch little Rikkie before she hit puberty they would have to start four or five years earlier than they did. By waiting to age 15, they would have to try to reverse changes that had already occurred, like a

voice drop and a larger penis and many other things. Problem is, if they take this back to when they needed to, at age 10, the year would be 2011, and except for intersex, almost no one was doing trans therapy on kids at that time. So the math again tells us this is almost certainly a fake.

Her name is also a clue: Rikkie Valerie Kolle. Wikipedia has a page on her and gives only that name, with birthname hidden. Other sites tell us she changed her name from Rik. But, as here, Rik is normally short for some form of Richard. But all we get is Rik. We aren't given a middle name. Couldn't have been Valerie, could it? So we are supposed to believe she changed both the first and middle names, I guess. So what was her original middle name? Cohen? Goebbels? We don't know, but the fact it is being hidden is not a good sign. As is the fact that Wiki doesn't tell us her parents, as it should. It normally does in cases like this.

Rikkie Kolle is a young woman who grew up in a mixed family. Her mother, Vjet Teke, is a Vietnamese immigrant who came to the United States as a refugee after the Vietnam War. Her father is unknown, as he left before Rikkie was born. Rikkie also has two siblings: an older brother Jalan Niek, and a younger sister, Isa Kolle.

So many problems there, but let's start with the huge glaring contradiction. If her unknown father left before Rik was even born, then why does her younger sister also have his name Kolle? And just because he left doesn't make him unknown. I guess we are supposed to believe the mother was knocked up by a soldier who didn't tell her his name, but did he come back a year later and knock her up again, and she still didn't bother to ask his name, though his baby son Rik was sitting right there? And remember, this would have been in 2001, not during the Vietnam war, so they have their dates off by about 30 years. That woman couldn't be a refugee from the Vietnam War, since she wasn't even born then. And if she went to the US, how did she end up in Holland? Holland isn't in the US, last time I checked. Plus, does the mother look Vietnamese at all? Not even a little. The Vietnamese don't have natural blonde hair, do they? And according to other sites, Rikkie is half Moluccan, so that guy is

supposed to be Moluccan? Look them up: they look nothing like that. They are very dark natives, almost black. And where did Rikkie get her height? Not from those parents. Vietnamese people, male and female, are famously very short. They don't have 6-foot sons or daughters.

We are told Rikkie is from Breda, yet another clue, since we have seen it before in my research. It is a very wealthy town where many of the richest families live. It isn't a destination for single refugees, since they can't afford the rents. Which reminds us that that name Kolle is spelled wrong. It has the wrong accent. The name as used in the Netherlands comes from the German, so it would be spelled Kölle. But the name given us online is Kollé. Not pronounced the same, since the second is pronounced like Collie. Or at least Collay. That indicates to me they are fudging the name Koller, or better, von Koller. I suspect this girl's father is a tall Dutch/Austrian von Koller, with her mother being a Molluccan or other exotic black or Polynesian. That would explain why they have to hide the father with such ridiculous lies. The von Kollers are famous barons and generals of Austria, and they later married into the British peerage, being tied to the Loftuses, Marquesses of Ely. See Baron Franz von Koller, head of the Austrian army and Governor of Bohemia. Also Alexander von Koller, Austro-Hungarian Minister of War. They were closely related to the Hohensteins and Hohenzollerns through marriage. They also link us to the von Sydows, so Rikkie may be related to Max von Sydow.

And we find another problem with her brother's name Jalan, which is neither Vietnamese nor Dutch. It isn't Moluccan, either, since it comes from India. That would again confirm my guess she comes from peerage, since her exotic mother may have been picked up in India or its eastern territories by East India Company peerage types still active there to this day.

For another clue, let us return to that interview linked above, where we were listening to her voice. Now let us pay attention to what she is actually saying. She is talking about getting death threats and people telling her to kill herself. I believe that, since I get the same thing. But what is strange is how little affected she seems by it. She is dealing with it VERY well, I would say, especially considering that it just happened, and is still happening. I would say she is dealing with it so well because 1) she knows it is all a fraud, so she doesn't actually have to deal with being a trannie in real life. Those around her know it as well, so she is shielded. 2) She is shielded even more because she is protected by Dutch and US Intelligence, and knows it. As an asset, she has 24-hour protection, lives in an undisclosed location, and travels incognito. She is part of this invisible class of peers that interacts not at all with regular people, so she has nothing to fear.

Finally, remember that Miss Netherlands is an entrant into Miss Universe, which was recently bought by a trannie, Thai mogul Khun Anne Jakrajutadip. So you have the *cui bono* for this whole fraud right there. And what does the Khun signify? We are supposed to believe it is just a Thai honorific, but it may also be a noble title. In which case we should ask where it comes from. It is pretty obvious, isn't it? Khun=Kuhn=Kohen. She took her mother's surname, not her father's, which is a Phoenician trick, pointing to matrilineal succession. Her father is Ashira Suthisataporn, and Ashira is a semitic name, coming from the Sumerian fertility goddess Asherah, and the original tribe of Asher.

As for Rikkie's birth sex, the only way we would know for sure is a look at the genitals, and you can be sure we aren't going to get that. And even if we did get photos, we know those are almost sure to be doctored by Intel. So for myself, I don't believe anything anymore that I don't see in person with my own eyes. Especially when it comes to the question of trannies. I would believe it if it accidentally showed up in my bed. Otherwise, not. Since that isn't going to happen, I have to judge this on the evidence at hand, all of which points in the direction of another fraud. Nothing else is real right now, so why would this be real?

*I predict some will say she *does* have a scar, since we see a line in that area in that interview. But that isn't a scar, it is natural wrinkle, and most real women have that. Don't believe me?
