## NaturalNews continues the Fear Porn

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As if in answer to my paper of five days ago on Cycle 26, calling out Mike Adams by name as a fear monger, he is now pushing this again, promoting Valentina Zharkova and her "theory" based on nothing that we are entering a Grand Solar Minimum and "the coldest period on Earth". According to her, beginning in 2030 there will be a food shortage due to lack of vegetation and worldwide starvation. Funny, since she and others were saying the same thing in 2017, just six years ago, except then they were saying it had already started. These jokers were predicting that we had already entered a Grand Solar Minimum in 2017 and that it would last decades. They claimed we were going to skip Cycle 25, which according to the mainstream started in December of 2019. They claimed there would only be a handful of sunspots during the entire 11-year cycle from 2019 to 2030.

Like Fauci, they claimed this was based on "science", but the only real science it was based on is the real Solar Minimum of 2017-2020, which was indeed very deep. It was the worst minimum since 1812, and I was telling my readers that from the beginning. It was both long and deep, with sunspots bottoming out to absolute zero in some months, and hanging on for almost four years. But that is FOUR YEARS, not decades. Solar Minimum is always about three years long, so this one was only *one year* longer than normal. And Solar Minimum commonly bottoms out to 20, so 0 wasn't far below that. So we now know they were very wrong. Not only did Cycle 25 arrive pretty much on schedule, it has turned out to be much stronger than Cycle 24. Starting in 2020 sunspots went on a very steep climb, going from near-zero to over a hundred *per day* in about two years. There have now been thousands this cycle already. The mainstream (NASA/NOAA etc) never predicted a Grand Solar Minimum, but they did predict a weak Cycle 25, being about the same as Cycle 24. But that has turned out to be wrong as well. I predicted Cycle 25 would be much stronger, and that prediction has been right on the money so far. I am the only one in the world that has been hitting monthly predictions right on the head. Cycle 25 has turned out to be more like Cycle 23, which was quite strong; and I am predicting a *very* strong Cycle 26, which may even rival the huge Cycle of the late 1950s.

None of these university people, including Zharkova, have any mechanism for Solar Cycles. In other words, they don't know what causes them. Only I have explained that, which is why I can predict monthly numbers years in advance. Zharkova and the rest of these academics can only push computer models, and they do that by feeding in all past data and asking the computer to spot patterns. Cycle 25 will spin down by them, and we will be in another Solar Minimum, so numbers will naturally be down again. They go down every eleven years. So at that time they will jump in and claim they were right: numbers are way down, be very afraid! But as I have told you, Solar Minimum in 2030 won't be as bad as the last one. It won't go down to zero, it will only go down to about 30, which is a real improvement. And it won't last four years.

Some will complain that I am attacking Infowars and NaturalNews, since they are on the right side of many topics now. That is true. They often seem to be promoting the revolution. But stories like this indicate to me they are controlling the opposition. They promote the revolution right up to the time it starts, then sandbag it.
