

Year-End Report

Well, 2025 was another banner year. I recently said I was shooting for 150 papers, and the final count was 152, 116 on the history site and 36 on the science site. On the science site, there was big news and big papers on several fronts, starting with my prediction of Solar Cycle 25, which continues to hit, confounding the mainstream.
