The Weathermen were Fake

Hmmm. Aces and eights? Could it be a wildass coincidence? Could it be fate? Could it be passing comets or fairy dust or swamp gas?


The Weathermen were founded on the University of Michigan campus in Ann Arbor by Bill Ayers and Bernardine Dohrn. Two Jewish names, who would thunk it? Dohrn was originally Ohrnstein, if you don't believe me.



Wiki admits she is Jewish:

Her father was Jewish, although the name change was intended to obscure that, [3] and her mother, Dorothy (née Soderberg), was of Swedish background and a Christian Scientist. [4]

That's supposed to be her FBI most-wanted images. Silly, since they should have been able to find better images of her, seeing that she worked for them. She had already graduated law school and was working for the National Lawyers Guild. She was also a leader of SDS and RYM, which were both CIA or FBI fronts. So she should have had student and guild photos, as well as the usual family photos we all have. Her entire family wasn't on the run. Plus, she had allegedly been arrested and booked several times, so she should have had multiple booking photos. Those aren't mugshots, since the light is wrong, she would have been told to take off the jacket, there are no cards, they shouldn't be black and white, and the side view is wrong.

Alan Haber was the first head of SDS in Ann Arbor, his dad William being an economics professor there. So the idea he was some sort of radical is a non-starter. Alan spent eleven years as a student at UM, proving almost by itself he was just an actor and stooge. Amazingly, they admit at Wiki that he was linked to Tom Hayden, who was then the editor of the UM newspaper. Hayden is the ugly little guy that was allegedly married to Jane Fonda back then. Hayden and Haber collaborated on the *Port Huron Statement*, which became the manifesto of SDS in 1962. From my paper on the <u>UT Tower shooter</u>:

Don't believe me about SDS being a CIA front? Well, would you believe Tom Hayden? The man himself wrote a 2014 article for *The Nation* admitting many of his pals in the National Student Association and other Socialist organizations were CIA plants. He basically outs everyone but himself, including Donald Hoffman, Peter Eckstein (his predecessor as editor of the Daily), Harry Lunn, Gloria Steinem, and Allard Lowenstein. All Jewish, of course. Actually, Hayden does out himself, if you read closely enough. He says,

Personally, I never made it into a CIA front group, though I tried hard enough. I was "unwitting," in spook-speak. "Witting" was what the agency called people in the know. They first tested and recruited them into high positions in the student world, then administered a surprise security oath before telling them they were part of the CIA. Under the guise of the NSA, the CIA recruited me to write a pamphlet on the student civil-rights movement ("Revolution in Mississippi," 1961) for global distribution.

There it is, straight from the man himself. 1961 is just a year before he wrote the similar *Port Huron Statement*. That link to *The Nation* still works, by the way.

I encourage you to read Dohrn's Wiki page closely, since it will help you understand what is going on now with Black Lives Matter and other schism movements. They are doing the same thing this decade they did in the 1960s, though with even larger exclamation points.

Dohrn became one of the leaders of the Revolutionary Youth Movement (RYM), a radical wing of Students for a Democratic Society (SDS), in the late 1960s. Dohrn with ten other SDS members associated with the RYM issued, on June 18, 1969, a sixteen-thousand-word manifesto entitled "You Don't Need a Weatherman to Know Which Way the Wind Blows", in New Left Notes. The title came from Bob Dylan's song, "Subterranean Homesick Blues". [7] The manifesto stated that "the goal [of revolution] is the destruction of US imperialism and the achievement of a classless world: world communism." [8]

The manifesto also asserted that African-Americans were a "black colony" within a U.S. government that was doomed to overextend itself. And the RYM was needed to quicken this process. Dohrn said, "The best thing that we can be doing for ourselves, as well as for the [Black] Panthers and the revolutionary black liberation struggle, is to build a fucking white revolutionary movement." [7]

Compare that now to the claims all white people are racist. But it is even worse now because a white revolutionary movement for blacks would be shouted down as paternalistic and colonizing. Like men, whites are now being sold as beneath alliance. But I am showing you this schism was and is not natural. Left to themselves, blacks and whites, men and women, would get along. The schism was and is being manufactured by Intelligence, who want us fighting eachother instead of tossing them out on their asses.

And how did this Jewish actress get on the FBI most wanted list? Allegedly for heading the Days of Rage riots in October 8-11 1969. Oh, what do you know, aces and eights again. Just a coincidence, move on. But wait, no one died or was even seriously injured, so how does that justify being on the most wanted list? We are told they caused \$183,000 in damage, but most of that was National Guard payroll—and that was covered by you the taxpayer whether they were working or not. And the city actually made a profit since the groups paid \$243,000 to cover bail. You have to laugh. Or not, since your grandparents paid for it: remember, the groups were CIA fronts and CIA's payroll comes from your taxes. Except for that part that comes from the drug trade.

The Weathermen allegedly bombed a bunch of buildings as part of their war against the government, but again no one died or was seriously injured. So I guess that, like now, they just bombed a bunch of derelict buildings that someone wanted to collect insurance on, the Target stores of the time. That's convenient for the script, right?

Dohrn and Ayers allegedly went into hiding until 1980, though charges were dropped in 1973. Make sense of that if you can. I guess they didn't read the papers. "In hiding" means they were still living in Chicago, known to everyone, but Dohrn changed her name from Bernardine Dohrn to Bernarndine Ohrnstein. That was all it took to fool the witless FBI and Justice, of course. When she came out, she allegedly spent seven months in prison for refusing to testify against fellow Jewish spook Susan Rosenberg, but we can be sure she wasn't there. By the 1980s she was working for the law firm Sidley Austin, so you can be sure they knew the entire story was vaudeville. We are supposed to believe she hadn't been admitted to the Illinois bar despite passing the exams, but that is absurd. Sidley Austin would have never hired a lawyer that couldn't be licensed. By the 1990s she was a professor at Northwestern School of Law, which—if her previous story were true—would be even more ridiculous. Why would Northwestern hire a person that had been on the most wanted list? But don't expect any of this to make sense, please. It was written out of Langley, so you have to believe it no matter how stupid it is. She worked in that position for 22 years, even founding a Justice Center as part of the Bluhm Legal Clinic there, all this said to be possible because she was "adjunct" and so her appointment did not require faculty approval. Whatever that means. Who "appointed" her? Professors are normally hired, not appointed.

Now for Bill Ayers, the creep pictured under title above. I have outed the Ayers family in literally dozens of papers, starting with the <u>fake Salem witch trials</u>, where they were front and center. And we have seen UM many times as well, as one of the premier big universities infiltrated by CIA, going back to <u>Ted the Head Kaczynski's</u> time there. [In fact, we just saw UM in my paper on Sam Altman.] Most people don't know that Ayers' father Thomas Grieg Ayers was the filthy rich CEO of Commonwealth Edison, and that the College of Commerce and Industry at Northwestern was named for him. Ayers was also the chairman of the board of trustees at Northwestern, the Erikson Institute, the Bank Street College of Education in New York, the Chicago Symphony, and the Chicago Urban League. He was on the board of directors of Sears, Searle, Pacific Corp, Zenith Corp, General Dynamics, First National Bank of Chicago, the Chicago Cubs, and the *Chicago Tribune*. So this guy was a titan among titans,

giving you the full lay of the land here.

What are the odds that the "revolutionary" Weathermen should come out of General Dynamics, the First National Bank of Chicago, and the *Tribune*? Just another coincidence, right? Can you believe they sold this crap back in 1969 and people bought it? CAN YOU BELIEVE WIKIPEDIA IS STILL SELLING IT AS REAL IN 2025? If your intelligence isn't insulted by this, you don't have any.

And the news stories you are getting now are the same sort of thing. Absolute intelligence-insulting garbage, spewed out of the sewers of Langley, the Pentagon, the Air Force, the universities, the magazines and newspapers, TV and internet, and who knows where else.

You won't believe who else this links us to. Thomas Grieg Ayers is scrubbed after his father Jule Caesar Ayers, with the genealogy sites hiding this line. So I went to thepeerage.com. There we find some Ayers from the US in the British peerage, including Lou Birchie Ayers of Mississippi, who married William Jefferson Blythe II, son of Henry Patton Foote Blythe. She died in Grayson County, TX. Who cares? You should because her grandson or great grandson was William Jefferson III/IV, aka . . . Bill Clinton. Yes, that Bill Clinton. Bill Clinton is listed in the British peerage as William Jefferson Blythe IV, son of William Jefferson Blythe III. So why did he change his name? To break this link to the British peerage, of course. You are supposed to believe he is some drawling hick from Arkansas, not a British lord, related to Adams, Wilson, Baum, Lockhart, Hines, Cassidy, Grisham, Mitchell, May, Newell, Howard, Champion, Shoup and Russell. Clinton's Ayers come from the Ayers of New Jersey, see Nathaniel Ayers, d. 1777. The Mary Ayers who was hanged was the sister of Obadiah Ayers, Sr., father of John Ayers of Newbury.

And I finally hit paydirt at Geneanet, where they have <u>Jule Caesar Ayers</u>, grandfather of Thomas Grieg Ayers of Chicago. He leads us directly back to this same Obadiah Ayers of Essex County as well, proving Bill Ayers and Bill Clinton are cousins, and that the US Ayers are British peerage, related to Russells and Howards, and therefore. . . Stuarts. In fact, this is why Tim Dowling at Geneanet lists them while no one else does: he is a Stuart.

By the way, Tim Dowling doesn't give the links, but of course Henry Patton Foote Blythe also takes us to the wealthy Pattons and Footes, including <u>General Patton</u>. Also of interest is that these Ayers become Montgomerys and Crocketts in the maternal line in about 1800, linking us not only to Davy Crockett but to the Stewarts. Dowling scrubs these Stewarts of Ireland, as well as the Montgomerys, which is very suspicious, being that Dowling is a Stewart himself, and this Sarah Stewart is admitted at Wiki to have been an Ulster-Scot, meaning she was from the Scots Stewarts directly.
