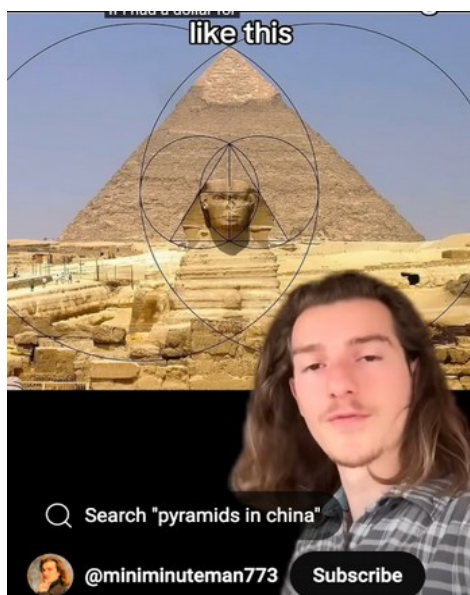


Fake News Shifts into Next Gear Overnight

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I noticed this first at Youtube, which seems to have been rebooted overnight. My old subjects were no longer being pushed, and the computer seemed to have forgotten who I was. No more 70s music, kittens, or Ozzy Man, but a whole new raft of fake news, [led by the guy above](#). Some annoying kid on speed with a flying skull tattooed on the back of his hand pretending to be an expert on everything. What did I do to deserve this? He apparently only does shorts, but claims to have 2.55 million subscribers, so why is he just appearing on my feeds this week? He has a link to a website, but there we find no bio, just this:

Milo Rossi's work has been featured and highlighted by National Geographic, Piers Morgan, Society for American Archaeology, the Republic of Türkiye Ministry of Culture and Tourism, and the Penn Museum.

That's not really telling us who he is, other than that he appears to be a promoted agent of some sort. Confirming that is that we find you can buy a "Fool" t-shirt or hoodie from him, for \$34 or \$55, with the Tarot fool very large on the back. You being the fool for falling for this. We also see he has spooky rings on six of his eight fingers. Not really getting a warm fuzzy from this guy, are we?

He claims to be debunking pseudoscience, with especial rancor focused on Graham Hancock and his ancient civilizations theories. Not sure what that is about, but best guess is it has something to do with Rossi's connections to the Turkey Ministry of Tourism. He may also be working for the Egypt Ministry of Culture, which hates Hancock for not believing the pyramids are tombs. I am no fan of Hancock, as I have said before, but I get an even darker vibe from this kid.

They are also pushing people screaming and fighting on me for no reason. Not boxing matches, just idiots on the street yelling and punching one another. I have never searched on this, so they must be feeding this to me to rile me up. A small part of Operation Chaos.

Then I saw [this video by Hollywood Access](#), not to be confused with Access Hollywood, which appears to be a straight-up fake story. Not sure why Youtube hasn't deleted it, since it claims the government shut down Blue Origin after it was determined to be a fake. It also claims Bezos cried when he heard that. None of that is true, but the video has been up for 10 days and the channel has been up for more than a year. So what is going on? My assumption is this is official government propaganda, allowed to stand for now, since it acts as an Anti. In others words, this is flagrantly wrong *on purpose*, and they know many people will figure that out. It is hoped that when people flush this analysis of Blue Origin, they will flush everyone else calling out Blue Origin as a fake and return to the safety of the mainstream story. So it acts to protect Bezos from criticism, you see. It makes all conspiracy theorists look crazy.

The same weirdness is going on off Youtube. At *Gateway Pundit*, for instance, we find Jim Hoft pushing [this story of an AI recreation](#) of a murdered guy being used in court. We are supposed to believe the victim's sister fed his images and voice into a computer, then gave it a script she wrote. So the victim appears to speak to the jury from beyond the grave. You can already see there is no possibility a judge would allow such a thing in a real courtroom. The defending attorney would also not allow it, since it is clearly emotional fiction created to sway the jury. And yet we are told:

the video moved the judge, who openly praised the AI technology, to hand down a sentence a full year longer than prosecutors requested.

Absolutely ridiculous. No lawyer or educated person would believe that. So this either must be a fake trial, or no trial at all—just one made up by some AI writer to sell AI. Amazingly, no one in comments suggests that. Many are very much against this being allowed in court, but no one considers the possibility **this never happened**.

Strangely, we get no specifics, like where or when this trial took place, who the judge was, who the attorneys were, or where the murderer was sent to jail. Obviously to make it impossible to confirm. Hoft gives a link to [AZ Family](#), but that too is strange since you would expect a link to some major news outlet. *AZ Family* appears to be out of Phoenix, and it fakes the form of a real news outlet, but I couldn't find that it actually was one. In fact the reverse, since I went to their [Meet the Team page](#), where I found this:



That's supposed to be reporter Casey Torres. Except for one big problem. It is no one. It is a computer generated image, and not even a good one. She doesn't exist, at least not in that form. Neither do any of the rest of the team, who are also bot-masks:



Funny how everyone working for this place wears flat red, with almost no wrinkles or puckers, and sharp edges where the fabric meets skin. Funny that their hair also has hard edges, like no one but AI has ever seen. This is just awful. So if those people exist, they exist as part of a very strange website

and organization, one drenched in AI and other weirdness, which should make you question any story coming from them about AI. My guess is that since this comes out of Phoenix, which is dotted with huge military installations, some of them secret, this channel is one of their many fronts, and one of the most transparent.

But we aren't done. Almost every story now in the news on every site appears to be a fake. In the sidebar to that last story at *Gateway Pundit*, we find [the one about the black guy who murdered an Uber driver](#). He was allegedly given life in prison without parole, and they have video of it from her back-facing dashcam, so you can watch it. That's so nice of them, right?



The video comes from the *New York Post*, so at least this is mainstream propaganda from established outlets, not fake AI outlets. But the biggest problem here is again the visuals, since the people in the video don't look anything like those people.



Look at his hand! He doesn't even look black. His voice doesn't sound black, either. His voice doesn't sound like the voice of an 84 IQ, either. No match on the woman, either. You will say that is an old picture of her with the dark brown hair, but she was just 38 in the video, so she hasn't gone gray. She looks blonde or bald, or both. Why has she changed so much that she is unrecognizable? Answer: to test you. They need to know if you are still blind.

Also note that she has dark eyebrows and likes to wear eyeliner. But again, not in the video, where everything about her is blonde.

Also notice the video doesn't even look real. It looks greenscreened, which means they aren't even in a car. It would be dangerous to film this while driving, and they clearly didn't. Look closely at the edges of her head, which are unnatural. They flicker and flop, just like greenscreen. And I might add they are both terrible actors. This is another complete fake.

he wore no gloves, used an easily traceable phone app, allegedly held a gun up to Ms. Spicuzza's head in front of a camera, and didn't attempt to conceal her body.

He should have also shot the camera, or otherwise destroyed it. You will say he was too stupid, and didn't see it. But he did. We see him looking right at it.

CBS [reported](#):

Calvin Crew, the man convicted of killing Christina Spicuzza, a Pittsburgh-area Uber driver in 2022, has been sentenced to life in prison without parole.

Crew was not in the courtroom at his own request. The defense attorney spoke on his behalf, but the judge indicated in a private message that he maintains his innocence and

plans to appeal the sentence.

Presiding Judge EJ Borkowski granted his wish, but it didn't change the outcome.

What? That makes no sense. Must have been written by AI. So murderers can just not show up for their sentencing? Good to know. A judge would not reveal the contents of a private message. Why? *Because it is private.* If the judge reveals it, it is not private, is it? Only AI can be so stupid. A judge sentencing a murderer would not care whether he was maintaining his innocence or planning an appeal. Doesn't matter. It has no bearing on the sentencing so no judge would say that.

I can even tell you where they got his name, Calvin Crew. It's a scrunch of Calvin Klein and J. Crew. Clever, hunh? Vintage Langley.

As for the victim, Christina Spicuzza, she apparently exists, but the big computers think she is still alive. [See Radaris, which lists her as 42 and still alive.](#) When a person is deceased, Radaris says "deceased". We know that is her listing since it lists her birth year of 1983. The listing underneath, age 38, has the right age, but that can't be her since the birthyear is given as 1986. So she is 38 now, not in 2022. And it gets much weirder fast. Christina Spicuzza is related to Linda Spicuzza, 64, of Port Saint Lucie, FL, and Linda is related to Christen Koch, who also just happens to be 42. Hmm. Is Christen Koch the same as Christina Spicuzza, and is she just hiding out in Florida? We don't know, but the age match and first name near match is suspicious. Christina goes by Christi, since her mother calls her that, and Christen might as well. At any rate, this link to the Kochs is interesting, since everyone in the fake trial was Jewish, as usual, including judge Borkowski, prosecutor Schoedel, and detective Renko. And then of course we had a Howard as defense attorney, the Howards being first cousins of the Stuarts. Spicuzza is also related to Bayr, Greenwalt, Schwaderer, and Marrs. This is what we always find, as you know if you have been reading me for any length of time. It is always the same people running these fakes.



That's another strange photo [I got here](#). But as you see from the tag in the corner, it comes from their Facebook page. The long straight line between the guy in the middle and the boy in yellow doesn't look right. That is what jumped out at me immediately. But even weirder is that Christina is said to be the mother of all those kids, but she is way off on the end, the only one *not* holding one of them. And again, you can see she looks absolutely nothing like the lady in the Uber video.

But it gets weirder. Look even closer, and you will see that there are little red dots on all the faces, and in a couple of other spots as well. Those look to me like AI residue, where the program is measuring the faces.

The next thing I discovered is that one of those guys is supposed to be Brandon Marto, according to the last link Christina's life partner. One problem: none of the people search sites has her related to him. Not Radaris, not Instantcheckmate, not Intelius. We find her mother Cindy, age 69, apparently from Texas, but no one named Marto.

So why fake this? Easy, race wars. Yep, it is yet another one of those. It is continuing to spin out in that direction as [Crew asks for a retrial or appeal due to misconduct by the detectives and prosecutors](#). Detective Renko acted nothing like any real detective I have ever heard of, giving an interview with WPXI less than a month after Crew's arrest and long before the trial. He allegedly got approval for the interview with County Police Assistant Superintendent Victor Joseph, which is impossible unless this was a set-up. Renko also has a Facebook page dating back to 2012 where he rants about soft sentences for black criminals, recommending they be taken care of before making it to trial.

Don't let these scumbags make it to the courtroom, give them their justice before that...

Really, and you believe that? You believe a police detective is going to say stuff like that on his Facebook page, and the department is never going to find out in 12 years, much less reprimand him for it or fire him? They are going to assign him to this high-profile national case where a black man allegedly murdered a white lady in cold blood? The scripting here couldn't be any more hamhanded.

In that last article, we are told by **Deputy** DA Schoedel that the judge had already ruled Renko's Facebook posts as inadmissible, which makes no sense. Inadmissible on what grounds? In a real trial the judge could not possibly rule evidence like that inadmissible, since there would be no reason to. The judge has to give a legal reason. But our real clue here is in yellow. Did you catch that? The lead prosecutor is not the DA. She is the **Deputy** DA. I remind you of [my paper on O. J. Simpson, where I hit this first time](#). But I have hit it many times since then, since this is how they always do it. Marcia Clark was also the Deputy DA, the DA in Los Angeles having better things to do than stage this fake trial. Deputy DA's do not prosecute first-degree murders. This was the biggest case in Allegheny County in many years, so why would the DA skip it? Ask yourself that. He didn't wish to be famous, so he passed it to this Schoedel chick?



That is what comes up on a Google search for her, though it has been deleted from her Martindale profile. She has no rating there and no peer reviews. No other photos on the web. I found only one other result on a search for her, a 2021 case when she was still an assistant DA, the sexual assault retrial of restaurant owner Adnan Pehlivan. Pehlivan claimed the alleged victim, never named, invited him home, took him to bed, then changed her mind, asking him to leave, which he did. The jury deadlocked and a new trial was ordered. In 2022 charges were dropped and the second trial scrapped. So Schoedel lost that one. But she does seem to specialize in these made-for-TV fake trials of sex and race. You can see why they would tap her for this, right? She has nice hair, the most important thing for anyone on TV or the internet. Same reason they tapped the guy I used under title. I guess this is now qualification #1 for CIA. If you want to make it in the future and you don't have great hair, you had better buy an expensive wig pronto.
