

I Don't Like Mondays

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This is by request. A reader wanted me to look at the first school shooter, Brenda Spencer, from 1979. Her fake event was the inspiration for Bob Geldof and the Boomtown Rats' only hit *I Don't Like Mondays*—which I never knew until today. So that's your first clue. We can assume the spook Geldof was selling this event as real, as part of his assignment by MI6 or whoever.

The second clue is the photo above, of Brenda in leg manacles. You have to laugh. At age 16, she was just 5'2" in shoes and weighed 89 pounds, so why would she need leg manacles? Just for the theater. And does that look like prison attire to you? They wear knee socks and platform sandals in prison in San Diego? Good to know. And why is it in black and white? Everything was color by then. Maybe to hide her pretty red hair or her Phoenician purple socks? Also a problem is that various sources say she was both 16 and 17 at the time. Wikipedia gives both ages. We will see why below. According to the dates posted for her birth and the event, she was 16.

The third clue is the name Spencer, as in Lady Diana, Diana Spencer. The Spencers are dukes, closely related to the Churchills, as in Winston Churchill, and the royals.

The fourth clue is San Diego, military town USA. So we can assume this was run out of some nearby military base, maybe Miramar.

On the morning of Monday, January 29, 1979, Spencer began shooting from her house[3] at children across the street who were waiting for 53-year-old Principal Burton Wragg to open the gates to Grover Cleveland Elementary.[4]

What's wrong there, Sherlock? Elementary schools in San Diego didn't have gates in 1979. Have you ever seen elementary age children lined up outside a gate waiting for the principal to arrive and let them in? No. What would be the point of that? Well, the point here is to appear to explain how Brenda could achieve this mass shooting without going inside the building. Just put her in a house across the street with a rifle and a scope and 500 rounds of ammo and you are done.

I am not making that last part up, either:

In December 1978, while she was still on probation for breaking into the school, a [psychiatric evaluation](#) arranged by her probation officer recommended that Spencer be admitted to a mental hospital for [depression](#). Her father refused to give permission. For Christmas 1978, he gave her a [Ruger 10/22](#) semi-automatic [.22 caliber](#) rifle with a [telescopic sight](#) and 500 rounds of [ammunition](#).

Just what every teenager in the city needs, right? Was she a competitive target shooter? Nope. Though she was an award-winning photographer. As all mental patients and mass murderers are.

That summer, Spencer, who was known to hunt birds in the neighborhood, was arrested for shooting out the windows of Grover Cleveland Elementary with a [BB gun](#) and for [burglary](#).[\[15\]](#)
[\[17\]](#) Police reports and eyewitnesses did not mention the use of a BB gun during the school vandalism.[\[14\]](#)

So Wiki admits in the following sentence the story about the BB was false: there was originally no mention of a gun in official reports, so someone just made it up.

The next clue is principal Burton Wragg. Do you want to guess what his mother's maiden name is? Go on, you only need one guess. If you guessed Kohen, you win the prize, [since it is Kuehne](#), same thing. In Hebrew you remove vowels, so you get Khn either way. Burton has a Findagrave page, but instead of a photo of his grave, we have a photo of the event memorial stone. **Burial: burial details unknown.** So if there is no gravesite, why have a page for him at Findagrave, which is the whole purpose of the site, as you can tell right from the name? Just to continue the fake.

Same for the other victim, janitor Mike Suchar, whose Findagrave page also says **burial details unknown.** Why would the janitor be out at the front gate at 8am? Also, his name has been changed, since his father is listed as Suhar, not Suchar. Mike's brother Suhar just happened to be an Air Force major. His other brother Suhar was Army Air Corps. Another brother Suhar was also Army. A search on the Suhars of that area finds they are not poor Hispanics, as we are led to believe from the reports of Mike Suchar, which is probably why they changed the spelling of his name. See for example cardiologist Chris Suhar, living in a \$3 million home according to FastPeopleSearch. He is related to Sylvia Suhar, 86, of Loveland, OH. Who else is from OH? That would be Mike Suchar, born in Campbell, OH, according to his Findagrave page.

A 28-year-old police officer, Robert Robb, had responded to a call for assistance and she shot and wounded him in the neck as he arrived.[\[5\]](#)

Robb prevented further casualties by moving a garbage truck in front of the school entrance to obstruct her line of fire.[\[6\]](#)

Ole officer Rob Robb, eh? Moving a garbage truck in front of the school? They really think we are stupid. After the first shot the children would scatter and you couldn't hit one if you tried, scope or not.

And once they scatter there is no blocking the line of sight with one garbage truck. They should have all run in the front door, right, limiting casualties to one or two, not ten. They all just loitered outside waiting for Robbie Robb to move the garbage truck in front of them? Principal Wragg was dead so no one could open that pesky gate! No one could find the key on his rotting body! No one could kick the gate open, though it was just flimsy waist-high chainlink. So they had to wait out by the street while little Rose Red across the street picked them off one by one.

After firing thirty-six times,[3] Spencer barricaded herself inside her home for several hours. She spoke by telephone to a reporter from *The Evening Tribune*, who had been calling random telephone numbers in the neighborhood. Spencer told the reporter she had shot at the school children and adults because, "I don't like Mondays. This livens up the day." She told police negotiators that the children and adults whom she had shot were easy targets and that she was going to "come out shooting".[5][7][8] She surrendered and left the house after being promised a Burger King meal by negotiators.[5][9]

That's the lie they came up with to explain how they got her number without knowing her name. But it doesn't work because telephone numbers aren't assigned like that, are they? If you are calling random numbers, how do you know they are in that neighborhood? Are we supposed to believe they called ten thousand random numbers with a San Diego area code, asking each person who answered if they had just killed some kids across the street? And notice how they got some free advertising for Burger King in there.

One thing I quickly discovered using the people searches is that this Brenda Spencer doesn't exist. The computers know her as Elyce Karen Spencer, now 66, not 64, of El Cajon, and she is not listed for the location of the jail in Chino where she is allegedly incarcerated. You will say that is her older sister, but Brenda does not appear on the lists of her parents Wallace or Dorothy Nadine, only Elyce and Teresa.

That is a screenshot from Instantcheckmate, but Radaris, Intelius, and FastPeopleSearch tell us the same thing. Elyce married Frank Mooney and is now Elyce Mooney. Dorothy is nee Hobel according to Wiki, but according to Instantcheckmate, Radaris and Instantcheckmate she isn't related to any Hobels. Teresa Ruth, formerly married to Halleran, is 67, so I am assuming a sister of Elyce.

Wikipedia tells us Brenda is the youngest of three siblings, but there is also a Scott Spencer, 69, listed at FastPeopleSearch who looks like the third sibling, so we don't even have room for a Brenda. We have Scott, Teresa, and Elyce. No Brenda.

Brenda's father Wallace Edward Spencer is also a ghost, because although he allegedly died in 2016, we find no Findagrave or obituary on the internet. According to his age at Instantcheckmate, he was born about 1929, but nothing comes up on that. He is listed at FastPeopleSearch and Radaris, but not related to Dorothy Spencer his first wife nor to any second wife. In fact, he isn't related to ANY Spencers at all. So does he have any aliases? Only Spencer Wallace, but he isn't related to any Wallace's, either, so that looks like a dead-end. We will search on Edward Spencer in a moment. But it is strange that he isn't related to any Spencers because according to the mainstream story, he remarried a year after the event, supposedly marrying a cellmate of his daughter who . . . get ready for

it . . . was the same age and looked just like her. She got out of jail and she and Wallace moved to Arizona. Yes, they admit that, but I found no name for this girl and no picture of her.

FastPeopleSearch and Radaris don't know Wallace Spencer is dead, so maybe he isn't. That would explain why we don't find an obituary. Radaris, FastPeopleSearch and Instantcheckmate have no location outside San Diego for Wallace of Yuma, Arizona, only Boulder, CO. The only possible wife I found for Wallace Spencer is Dosie Connor, 98, of Detroit, who is on his list but is related to no Spencers.

In more weirdness, FastPeopleSearch tells us Wendy K. Spencer, 40, is married to Elyce Spencer, though I think she is more likely to be her daughter—the one supposed to be the mystery daughter of Wallace Spencer. At any rate, her email address is given as tormented_soule@-----.com. That is public information if you want to look it up for yourself. So is she tormented because her mother or aunt is a famous murderer, or is she tormented because her mother is part of this fraud? She does share a current address with Elyce and Frank Mooney, so I guess whoever she is she never left home. Jesse Spencer, 36, has also lived there, so probably her little sister.

So have you solved the mystery, Lestrade? Wasn't hard, was it, given that last clue, which sort of knocks you over. "Brenda" Spencer was never in jail, she just changed her name and moved back in with her father in early 1980, if not before. As cover he pretended to marry her and they moved out of that house—if they were ever there. Hard to believe they thought that obvious switcheroo would work, but I guess it did with most people. And if you didn't buy it back in 1980 and said so, I don't think they were going to interview you for the 6 o'clock news or print your letter to the editor.

Anyway, guess what current address they have for Wallace Spencer, 97? 6356 Lake Atlin, same house he was in in 1979. He's been there for 54 years, so go say hi. You will be like Brad Pitt visiting George Spahn in *Once Upon a Time in Hollywood*. Brenda/Elyce won't be there since she is in El Cajon. That house is still there, but the school is not. They tore it down for a housing complex. By the way, that also conflicts with the story he and his teen wife moved to Yuma, Arizona, in 1980. That would either mean this dirt-poor guy kept up the payments on two houses, or later came back and bought the same house he had sold in 1980.

No luck on Edward Spencer, around 97, of San Diego.

Let's fill in some interesting holes on the way out. Bob Geldof is a Jewish **Falk** of London through his grandmother, which links us to the King like this: Beatrice Falk of the peerage married Sir **Levy Lever**, 1st Baronet, and their son the 2nd Baronet married Clodagh **Bowes-Lyon**, granddaughter of the Earl of Strathmore, who was himself grandfather to the old Queen Mother (Elizabeth II's mother). This means Geldof is a near cousin of the Spencers, not only through Lady Diana but through previous marriages of the families. So we may deduce he didn't just accidentally get involved in this event in the US, promoting it just a few months after it happened. And if that is true, then that means these Spencers in San Diego aren't just poor nobody Spencers, they are related to THE Spencers. Which explains why all those links have been scrubbed, with Wallace Spencer mysteriously being linked to zero Spencers in all the people searches.



She looks really happy, doesn't she, and why not? Who wouldn't be happy having spent 15 years in maximum security, with a great haircut and nice clothes? And she gets to be there with a lot of other pretend Hollywood inmates, including the fake Manson family, Belushi's murderer, and many other stars. Just check out the Wiki page for famous inmates of the California Prison, Chino, which reads like a who's who list of media celebrities, pushed in books and movies. Joe Pesci's ex-wife; Emily Harris of the fake Symbionese Liberation Army; LAPD detective Stephanie Lazarus; Lucille Miller, star of Joan Didion's *Slouching towards Bethlehem*; fake serial killer Dorothea Puente, the Killer Landlady; Barbara Graham, subject of the film *I Want to Live*; and Julia Diaz, featured on *Deadly Women: Heartless Souls*. So like many other prisons, this one has a big fake wing for these CIA actors.

At her first hearing, in 1993, Spencer said she had hoped that police would shoot her, and that she had been a user of alcohol and drugs at the time of the crime. However, results of drug tests done when she was taken into custody were negative.

So again, they just admit the story is a lie and that Spencer is making it up as she goes. She wasn't from poverty, wasn't living in squalor, wasn't an alcoholic and druggie, didn't get arrested for shooting out the school windows, and didn't have a BB gun. So how much more proof do you need this is fiction? Wikipedia publishes all the clues without us even having to go through fake court documents or something. They admit the school had been closed since 1983, and my guess is it was already closed before that, in 1979, like Sandy Hook. We later discovered Sandy Hook was already defunct at the time of that event, the Wayback Machine listing it as inactive for several years. So this elementary school was also derelict by 1979, and they just made up this whole story from scratch.

Due to declining enrollment, the school was closed in 1983, along with a dozen other public schools around the city.[29]

Very suggestive, you have to admit. So I took that link then continued to search on it, [taking me here](#), where I discovered many of those dozen schools were closed BEFORE 1983. 1983 was just the end of that cycle, but many were closed years earlier. For example, Benchley was closed in 1980. It says there that Cleveland closed in 1983, but he is just repeating the mainstream story from the Spencer event, as he admits.

Finally I found this photo at [Medium.com](#), which continues the joke:



That is tagged “injured children”, but I don't see any injuries or blood, do you? And who is the dude in a flower shirt lifting the blond boy upside-down from the stretcher while the fake medic looks on in astonishment? Why not just roll the boy into the hospital on the stretcher, since that is what they are made for? Maybe that is his Dad, since they are both wearing flower shirts: Dad is stealing his boy back from the CIA before this goes any further. And why is that in Christmas colors while all the photos of Spencer continue to be black and white?



That's her mugshot update for 2020. So many problems. She's supposed to be 58 there, been in for

almost 40 years. So what's this Golden Program? Special rewards for prisoners who avoid parole for 50 years, and she is almost 4/5ths of the way there? They glue it to the end of a ruler and re-photograph you every ten years, with door prizes at the end? But the bigger problem is how fat she is. Do those on the Golden Program get double rations? Doesn't sound like a good deal for taxpayers, since double rations costs twice as much. Prisoners shouldn't be fed enough to get fat, on general principles. At any rate, we now know this is all a fake: like Manson she just comes in when needed for some new photos, to allegedly prove she is there. But she looks awful for 58, so the life of fraud must not have agreed with her. Wasn't the right choice, was it, "Brenda"?
