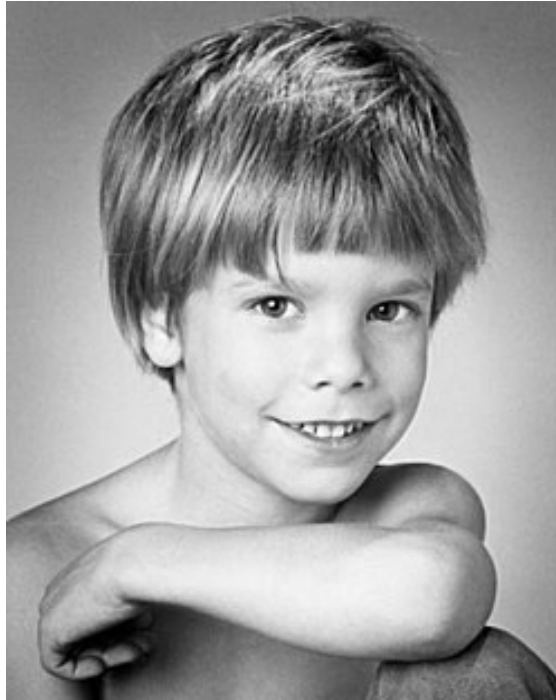


The Disappearance of Etan Patz

Don't worry, he didn't die, and I'm about to prove it, using nothing but mainstream sources.

Here's another one a reader suggested to me. The allegedly death of Etan Patz in 1979. He is the six-year-old boy from Soho that started the milk carton “have you seen me” project, which we can now blow the cover of as another CIA project—part of Operation Chaos. How do I know? As in my previous paper of earlier today, I just did a people search on him. I started at Instantcheckmate, but didn't find him there. Intelius and Instantcheckmate are often scrubbed, since they come out of Israel, but Radaris and MyLife often aren't. You will say I shouldn't find him in these people searches since they don't list children. That's right, but here is what I found at Radaris:

He would now be 52, but no age is listed. You will say there may be more than one Etan Patz, which is true, but notice they give you a middle initial. K. What is our Etan Patz's middle name? Kalil. So there you go. Plus, in fact there is NOT more than one Etan Patz, not according to Instantcheckmate and Intelius. They both return ZERO Etan Patzes in the entire US. That's because the name is normally Ethan, not Etan.

Etan's father Stanley just happened to be a professional photographer, so he had lots of photos like the one above lying around they could use for the milk cartons. So that's convenient.

And there's more. Etan's younger brother Ari also has a location in Florida, though it is St. Augustine, not St. Petersburg. His sister Buffy Cushman-Patz has four locations in Florida, including St. Augustine, Sanford, Gainesville, and New Smyrna Beach. None of those are proximate to St. Petersburg, but we can be sure Etan K. Patz of St. Petersburg has more than one location in his whole life. They have obviously done a partial scrub there, but somehow the listing survived.

Before we move on, I remind you that Etan Patz is a Jewish name. His father is **Stanley**. Family members also use the name Batz. See Julie Batz, 46, of Alameda, named for her mother Julia, I guess. You would think they would know how to spell their own name. Through these Batzes of California, we find them related to **Kennedys and Hoffmans**. Through the Buffettas they are also related to Spencer, Zimmerman, Redford (including a Robert Redford), **Stewart**, and Schreiber.

If we click on Etan K. Patz there at Radaris, we find he is related to Barretts. So we take one of them, Anastacia Barrett, back to Instantcheckmate for more information. We find her also related to Balog

and Spinelli. In fact, Radaris tells us she was aka Anastacia Balog, Anastacia Gatley, and Dana Spinelli. Instantcheckmate gives us no more information on those names that would link us to Stanley Patz of New York, but I am just collecting names. You will see why.

Anastacia is related to Daniel Balog of St. Petersburg, 68, and he also has North Hollywood on his list. His son, same name, has Falls Church and DC on his list, which is. . . yep, CIA. According to LinkedIN he is now a sports agent, but it doesn't tell us what he was doing in DC or Falls Church. He is related to Ines Villalobos of Beverly Hills.

But back to the story:

When Etan did not return home after school, his mother Julie called the police. At first, detectives considered the Patzes to be possible suspects but quickly determined they had no involvement. An intense search began that evening, using nearly 100 police officers and a team of bloodhounds. The search continued for weeks.

Impossible, since the police will not devote officers to a missing person that fast, not even a child, unless there is absolute proof of foul play, like blood or a note or a witness to a kidnapping. Nonetheless, the Patzes soon got Etan's image up on the giant screens in Times Square. How did they manage that? Children go missing all the time, so why was this one given such incredible promotion? That should already be a huge red flag, without anything else.

The case was stalled for six years until they found a guy named Jose Ramos, a convicted child molester. For twenty years the story was he did it, despite zero evidence and the police refusing to prosecute, and the Patzes even won a judgment against him, one he couldn't pay. Someone forged testimony from a cellmate, indicating Ramos knew the bus route Etan took, etc. Except it turns out he didn't do it, since in 2012—33 years later—a “retarded” guy named Pedro Hernandez confessed to the killing. He had been 18 at the time, and he claimed to have choked Etan when he came into his convenience store, throwing his body in the garbage. Right. Impossible, since as I have shown you before, people with IQ 70 are not qualified to work such jobs, and weren't in 1979.

But the greater problem is that this Pedro Hernandez doesn't check out in a people search. We are told he is from Maple Shade, NJ, but the only Pedro Hernandez of Maple Shade is 53, making him seven years old at the time of the murder. Here is his 2017 picture, which tends to confirm that:



Is he 57 there or 46? I say he looks more like 46. He also doesn't look retarded, with an IQ of 70. It's in the eyes.

He is related to a Rosemary Hernandez of Maple Shade, and she links us to Prinzivallis, who link us to Skowronskis, who link us to Lobitzes. These Hernandezes also link us to Florida. The problem: Those names are Jewish, so Hernandez is part Jewish, making me think he is probably related to the Patzes. When researching them, I also found many Hispanic names.

In fact, with a lot of work, I found the hard link. The Patzes are related to the Cushmans who are related to a Louis Buffetta. He links us to Leigha Delgrosso, who is related to Del Toros, who are related to Rodriquez, who are related to. . . Hernandez. That is Vanessa Hernandez of Corona, NY, related to William Rodriguez of Kissimmee, FL, related to Evelyn Rodriguez of Brooklyn, related to Jovany del Toro of Colorado. Vanessa links us forward to Jose Hernandez of Flushing, who links us to Dtm Viktor Bazan, who links us to Cory Hoffman of Los Angeles, who owns grocery stores. I have already established above that the Patzes are related to Hoffmans of California through Julie Batz. She is related to the Thomas Cushman who is related to Etan Patz' sister Buffy. So there you have it. I knew I could dig it out.

Here's another problem:



That's the Patzes arriving at the Manhattan Supreme Court for sentencing in 2017. But look how she is dressed! You can't wear that to a Supreme Court. It is highly inappropriate for a 70-something woman to wear that to court, and she would be told to go home and change. You couldn't wear that to jury duty in your hometown, could you?

Hernandez was allegedly convicted in the second of two trials, but his conviction was just overturned last month. **They forgot to read him his rights before his confession.** Brilliant, right? And so believable. Miranda rights have been around since 1966, almost 60 years, but these prosecutors in one of the biggest cases of the past century just forgot to read him his rights. Such a rookie mistake! But we know this is all fake as well. How?

The appeals court said the trial judge gave a “clearly wrong” and “manifestly prejudicial” response to a jury note during Hernandez’s 2017 trial — his second. His first trial ended in a jury deadlock in 2015. The court ordered Hernandez’s release unless the 64-year-old gets a new trial within “a reasonable period.”

This isn't how it works, as any lawyer knows. A judge doesn't order a release “*unless* a prisoner gets a new trial quickly.” No, as soon as the guilty verdict is overturned on appeal, the prisoner is by legal definition not guilty again, in which case he must be released. In fact, a new trial would be double jeopardy, so there cannot be a new trial. You have heard of criminals being sprung on a technicality, right? Well, that is what just happened. The State made a major mistake and they don't get to just keep trying until they get it right.

You will tell me they sometimes do retry criminals after a conviction is overturned, but that is only in

the case that the mistake is correctable. Failure to read rights is not correctable since you can't reverse time. That article at CNN even admits that:

During nine days of deliberations, jurors sent repeated queries about those statements. The last inquiry asked whether they had to disregard the two recorded confessions, if they concluded that the first one – given before the Miranda warning – was invalid.

The judge said no. The appeals court said the jury should have gotten a more thorough explanation of its options, which could have included disregarding all of the confessions as improperly obtained.

So in a retrial, all confessions would be disregarded, and since that is all the prosecutors had to go on, no trial would be possible. Remember, there never was any body, murder weapon, or any other evidence. This is all just an unsubstantiated story. So in the real world, Hernandez would have to be released immediately for lack of evidence and lack of any conviction. The State has no reason to hold him. Of course he was never in jail for a second, since he is just another actor, so it doesn't really matter, I am just reminding you of the law. Plus, they never tell us where he was supposed to be serving this sentence, so I can't look it up. They may or may not have faked a jail entry for him. Sometimes they do; often they don't and I have caught them at it (see my paper on Johnny Hovey, for instance). Interestingly, if you search on this, the search is hijacked by [another Pedro Hernandez in Riker's Island](#).

And why would they fake all these child murders? I have told you many times: it is part of Operation Chaos and the Men-are-Pigs project, just like the fake serial killers, mass murderers, and school shooters. It creates fear, blackwashes men, splits the sexes, and destroys the family, allowing for greater levels of control, population control, increased police and military budgets, and much higher sales in security, anti-depressants, therapy, comfort food, guns, prepper gear, and thousands of other things.
