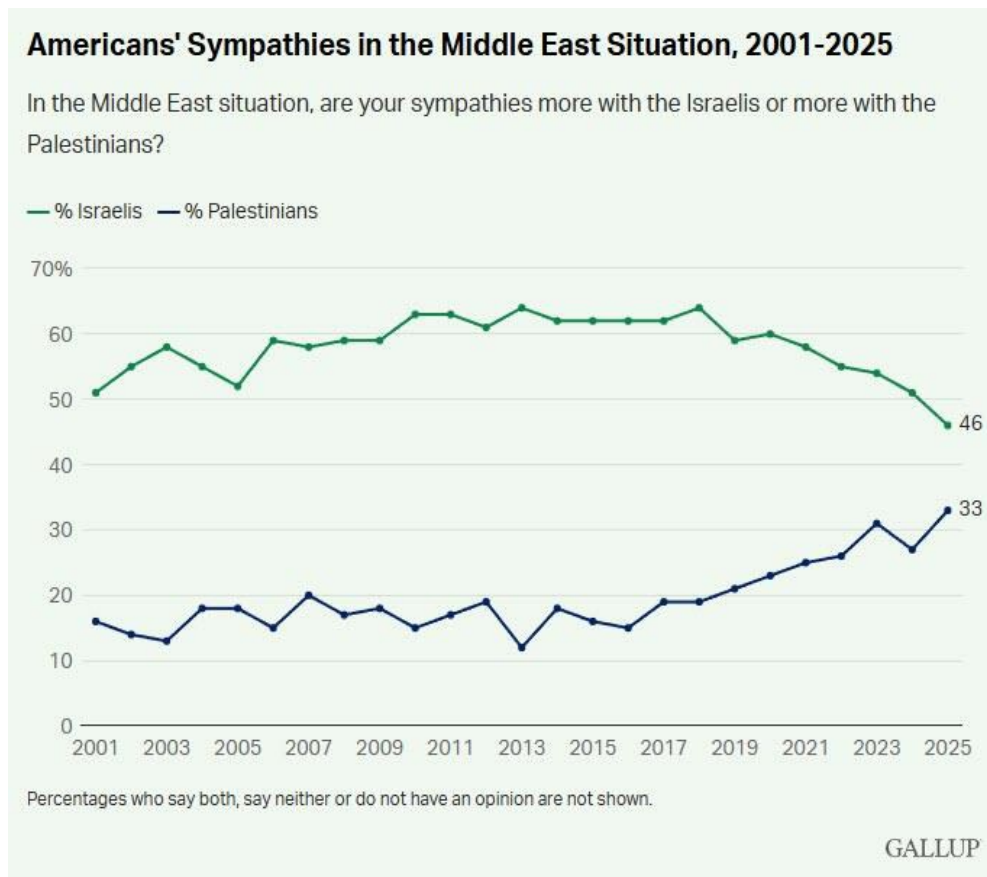


Support for Israel Dropping like a Rock



Despite David Schwimmer's best efforts, [support for Israel is in a freefall](#), as you see. And it is probably much worse than that, since all these pollsters like Gallup are Phoenician-owned. It is surprising to see them admitting this at all, in any form, and indeed this poll is not being widely reported by the mainstream. It is being pushed in some parts of the alternative press.

I will be told only strange leftists are pro-Palestinian, but that can't be the case, because the Democratic Party really is in a similar freefall. So this graph is upside down to that. There are now fewer Democrats and more Republicans than there were in 2013, so we should see a rising green line to go with that. Plus, Trump lines are going up in that period, and Trump is very pro-Israel, so we should see the green line follow Trump. But we don't. Just the opposite. Telling us that MAGA does not agree with Trump on this issue. Support for Israel has fallen 12 points among Republicans in just five years, and 38 points among Democrats—a complete disaster.

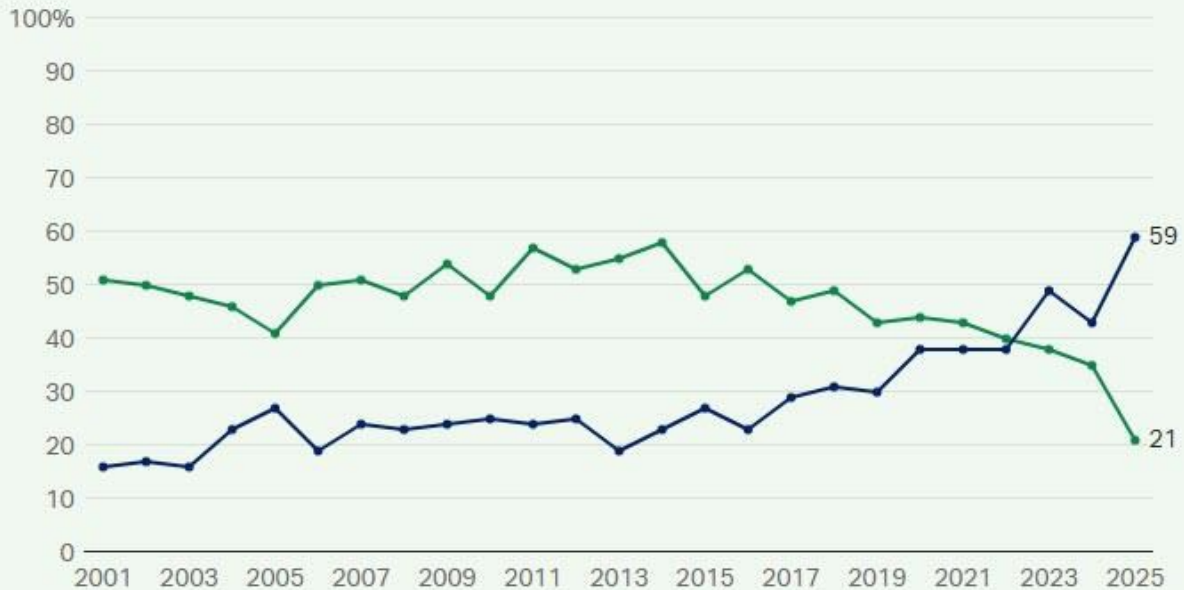
That is proved by other charts in the same poll, where we find a 45% approval rating for Trump, but only 40% approval of his Israel policy. Neither number is very good, but 40% is a Biden-level number. 55% still want a two-state solution and an independent Palestine, against 41% who don't, a gap of 14 points. So Americans, including conservatives, **do not** want to see Gaza wiped off the map or Palestine given to Israel to make a new Riviera.

But the most shocking thing about all this, at least for me, is something I haven't seen anyone else talking about. Jews and Jewish interests have skewed heavily to the Democratic Party, as you can see from Hollywood.
