Nick Shirley looks like yet another poorly disguised Agent

Why do I think that? Because this all happened way too fast to be natural. This nobody kid comes out of nowhere just a week ago, the day after Christmas, with no credentials and no history—and a suspicious two-year gap in his bio, he reports that an "N" fell off a sign and that some doors were closed at "Somali" daycare centers in Minneapolis, and within two days his channel has 118 million hits and the story breaks at a thousand sites simultaneously, including all the big alternative ones. How does that work? With no government investigation, Trump announces—based on nothing—that \$18 billion have been stolen by fake daycare centers, and the FBI and Justice immediately jump on it. Many Congresspeople also jump heavily onboard, though, as I say, there has been no time for even the most cursory investigation.

It now turns out Shirley and his mysterious pal "David" were in cahoots with the Republican party and the White House from the beginning, and Trump is already said to be cutting off funding for Minnesota —again based on nothing and against all law and precedent. That is money voted on by Congress and the President can't just nix it overnight on his own authority, based on a Youtube video.

I don't really like reporting this because I sort of hate to get in the way of fire aimed at Tim Walz, but I just tell it like I see it. Walz is no doubt involved in all sorts of skullduggery—what governor isn't?—and I am sure Minnesota is awash in fraud, but this latest thing has all the earmarks of another scripted hoax, one probably put together to steer your eyes off other news. That is what we always find. This one also appears to be part of the very obvious race wars, since the Somali angle plays into that. But Walz should fall on his own lack of merits and true crimes, not for this Langley theater.

In perhaps the worst example of this theater, see the story today from WND.com, reprinted at Infowars,

claiming Somali men are carrying billions of dollars out of the US in carry-on luggage. No, really:

Liz Jaksa, a former TSA agent who worked at the Minneapolis-St. Paul International Airport from 2016 to 2021, recently spoke to Liz Collin of Alpha News, as Collin noted the practice "sounds like something out of a spy movie – people going through security and getting on planes with suitcases filled with millions of dollars in cash."

Yeah, and you believe that? You can't get a pair of nail clippers through security, but these "low IQ migrants" are smuggling billions of dollars in cash out of the country under the noses of TSA and Customs?

Shirley is incredibly suspicious, since he was filming at the January 6 event, which my readers know was mostly staged. Though Shirley was only 18 then, we are told he sold or offered to sell some of his footage to the networks. Since he is from Utah, we have to wonder why he wasn't in school. Reminds us of John Sullivan, another young guy filming in DC that day who sold footage to the networks.



He turned out to the be son of Air Force Lt. Gen. Kevin Sullivan, so he was a Pentagon plant. Who planted Shirley in DC in 2021? Sullivan was allegedly convicted of five felonies (in dummy courts) but of course was pardoned by Trump. Shirley didn't need to be pretend-pardoned since his convictions weren't part of the script.

After that Shirley supposedly went to Chile for two years on a "religious mission" for the Mormons. Sure he did. Do we have any proof of that, like photos of him in Santiago? Because my guess is that is just a cover story for his time training in Langley or somewhere. Which leads us smartly to this:

In 2024, Shirley released footage from inside the maximum-security prison CECOT in El Salvador.[10] In October 2025, he participated in a White House roundtable discussion with Trump and other right-wing figures such as Andy Ngo and Jack Posobiec on topics including Antifa.[4][11]

So maximum security prisons in El Salvador just let in any Youtube kid who knocks on the door, allowing him to film at will? And what qualified a 23-year-old Shirley to participate in White House

discussions with Trump? Again, is Trump just inviting all self-proclaimed citizen journalists on the internet to the White House for discussions? I must have missed my invitation. Note Ngo and Posobiec there, since everything I say here about Shirley applies equally to them.

The month before, Shirley had scored an interview with covert British agent Tommy Robinson, who is hiding his peerage connections behind that pseudonym. He is really Stephen Yaxley-Lennon, and I have outed him already. His mother—unnamed at Wiki—was allegedly a baker, which we know means banker. Regardless, it is very weird to tell us she was a baker without telling us her name, either surname or Christian name. At any rate, you know about the Lennons—John Lennon's mother was a Stanley, remember—but I send you also to the Yaxleys of the peerage, closely related to the Russells, Barons of Killowen, and through them to the Ritchies, including Guy Ritchie. These Russells also link us immediately to the Forbes-Sempills. The Yaxleys also link us to Hong Kong. Robinson is also a Capell, of the Earls of Essex, meaning he is a cousin of Tiggy Legge-Bourke, the nanny for Prince William. We also link to the Allfreys, the Fox baronets, the Newton barons, the Latham baronets the Birkin baronets, the Dukes, the Barclays, the Booths, the Brabazons, the Guinnesses, the Chapmans, the Peakes, and the Hays, Marquesses of Tweedale. The Hays link us to Maitlands and Montagues, who take us to Gordons and Stuarts, so we are now right at the top. The point being that when Shirley interviewed Robinson, it was one agent interviewing another agent/cousin, as usual. Everything is now scripted.

Also strange we don't get parents for Shirley at Wiki, though we usually do in bios. A bit of digging on that <u>leads us to the claim</u> his father was Laurence Shirley who died in 2003 (when Nick was one), having previously run the local post office, the local pharmacy, and being a Farmington county councillor.

Unfortunately, I found no confirmation of any part of that story, either, since no obituary is listed for him online. The story is fishy, since how do you "run" the local post office and pharmacy at the same time? He was a pharmacist who moonlighted as the PO manager? How does that work? Amusingly, Laurence is also claimed to have been in the building industry for decades, where he got the asbestosis that killed him. So, let me see if I have this straight: he was a pharmacist and post officer manager and county councillor who had *also* been ripping asbestos out of walls and ceilings long enough to get cancer at an early age? Is this story ever going to start making sense?

What does come up instead of this Laurence Shirley is Laurence Shirley, the Earl Ferrers, which my readers know links us immediately to . . . the Stanleys, Earls of Derby. Those Shirleys also liked to spell it Laurence, instead of the more common Lawrence. Yes, I was suspicious from the first word, since I know who the Shirleys are. They aren't downmarket small-town Mormons, they are peers connected to all the top people on both sides of the pond.

The Shirleys are still Earls Ferrers as well as the Viscounts Tamworth, and as such they are also Allens and Kings, Earls of Lovelace. This links them to the Noels, Kennedys, Gordons, and Hamiltons, and therefore to the Stuarts. See for example Lady Hermione Shirley, b. 1982, who married Edward Crisp, son of the Grafin Grote-Varchentin, who links us immediately to the Princes of Wurttemburg, linking us to the Sachs (Saxes) and the kings of Germany, England, Russia, and most other European countries.

But here's how we *know* the story of Nick's dad is fake, straight from that page linked above:

So when he entered the hospice and was looked after with such sincere care and attention by all of the nurses and doctors, he asked me to donate what I could to help cover the cost of his

time there. Hence many years down the line I have not forgotten that conversation and am still today giving what I can.

Do you see it, Sherlock? These people can't do math, as usual, since this conversation was in 2003. Nick was born in 2002. So that's quite a conversation for an infant.

Radaris lists this Nicholas P. Shirley of Farmington and Kaysville, though they say he is 24 not 23, and they do not link him to Laurence. Only to Linda Simister, 25, so maybe a wife or sister. Probably not a sister, since she links to no Shirleys. Instantcheckmate also does not link him to a Laurence Shirley, the father possibly being Paul Lamar Shirley, 59, of UT and also Tampa, FL, and Ithaca, NY. The computer there links him to Kelly Brooke Simister, 26, not Linda Simister, and we also link to Matthew, Lindsey, Bruce, Lolita, and Ryan Shirley. Ryan Lamar Shirley, 35, may be an older brother, but he is scrubbed, with the dreaded *i*. He does have locations in one of multiple listings, where we find Philly, Orlando, Honolulu, and Brooklyn. Honolulu makes us think of the Youtuber Ryan Shirley and his travelogue. Are they related? Maybe, maybe not. They don't look alike. Brooke N. Shirley, 55, may be his mother, since she is the right age and matches all the locations of this family. You are going to love her maiden name. Crowley. As in Aleister Crowley. She also links us to a Samantha Fisher.

That is the Brooke Shirley linked to Nick, since she is listed that way on his page as well. Shirley-Brookes. I looked many of these people up at LinkedIN but found no smoking guns. Nick has been pretty well scrubbed, as you would expect, though not so well I couldn't make a pretty good case here.

I also researched the Simisters of Utah, finding them linked to the Simisters of Derby, England, who were also peers like the Shirleys. The Simisters of Utah are closely related to the Salmons, and of course Salmon=Solomon. See for instance Franklin Dewey Salmon, who travelled with the Mumford Company as an infant, being among the first generation into SLC in 1868. Wikitree admits these Simisters and Salmons are from noble lines, since they are related to many famous people, including Brigitte Bardot, Diane Keaton, Marianne Faithful, and Robert Redford.
